



Important Public Notice Flushing of Water Mains

April 24, 2006 to May 5, 2006

- **WHAT'S HAPPENING?** Water Mains are about to be flushed. This may result in discoloration of your water during the actual cleaning process and even the following day.
- **WHY?** Because water mains build up sediments which tend to restrict flow and cause discoloration during high usage.
- **WHEN?** Beginning Monday, April 24, 2006 to May 5, 2006.
- **WHERE SHOULD I CALL IF I HAVE QUESTIONS?** During business hours, 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. call 388-0226 and office staff will assist you. After hours call 388-0226, press 1 and the answering service will transfer your call to our 24 hour on-call person to handle your inquiry.

WHAT PRECAUTIONS CAN I TAKE?

- We suggest the regeneration of water softeners after 6:00 p.m. or before 7:00 a.m. from April 24, 2006 to May 5, 2006.
- We suggest that when you plan to wash clothes you first run some cold water in a sink or basin for a short time until it is clear.
- If you have any medical equipment that might be affected by a temporary lack of water or a reduction in water pressure, please call us and arrangements will be made to keep the equipment working satisfactorily.
- **WHAT WILL YOU DO IF I CALL?** During working hours, we will dispatch a Customer Service Technician or one of our Operations staff to assist you. After hours, a Customer Service Representative will be notified of your problem.
- **WILL MY AREA BE AFFECTED?** Work crews will be in the following areas:
